Introduction by Dr. Christine Rigden, Sherriff of the City of London



I was delighted to accept the invitation to write the forward to this Masters' Picture Book. I am proud to support this initiative of the Tylers & Bricklayers of which I am a Liveryman, and their first Sheriff in several hundred years. This, the seventh issue in five years, is indicative of its popularity.

As Masters you are all very well placed to act as ambassadors, not only for your own Liveries, but for the City of London in general. The Livery, the Business City, and the Civic City are inexorably linked.

The Civic City promotes UK financial and business services which contribute massively to our economy: 13% of GDP, £55million in trade surplus, and 7% of total UK employment. The Livery links closely with both the Business and Civic City supporting education, promoting professional standards and adding value to the Civic City and wider society.

This is in addition to other significant charitable foundations managed by the Corporation such as the City Bridge Trust which makes annual donations in Greater London of £18 million.
